1. Purpose

To provide foreign residents in Japan and Japanese practitioners who study Japanese martial arts with knowledge in not only the theory and techniques of Budo, but also deepen their understanding of historical and scientific aspects. It is hoped that this will contribute to the international development of traditional culture and foster goodwill through Budo.

- (1) Participants must be over 18 years of age, resident in Japan, be practising Budo with at least the rank of Shodan, and be able to communicate in Japanese or English as these will be the languages in which instruction is given.
- (2) Japanese participants should be over 18 years of age, be able to speak English at conversational level, and at least hold the rank of Shodan in a Budo art. In principle he or she should be recommended by an affiliate organisation of the Japanese Budo Association.
